Holmes Property Riparian Tree Planting

The Holmes Riparian Tree planting took place in the fall of 2008 to stabilize stream banks along the Cobourg Brook. The Holmes property has been a site of previous restoration projects including a logjam removal in 2006 and other riparian plantings in 2008. This riparian planting was at a site where the bank was unstable and subsequent work was carried out including installing LUNKERS and boulder placement within the stream. The OFAH staff had the assistance from a class of high school students to complete the riparian planting (fig. 1). In total the class and teachers planted 400 trees and shrubs along the stream bank (fig. 2).
