Hie Property Cedar Tree Transplanting

The Hie property was a site of a restoration project in 2008. At that time the Canada-Ontario Agreement funded a bank stabilization project. The bank was stabilized through the planting of trees and shrubs (figure 1). In 2009 it was evident that the property was in need of more plants to continue to increase the rooting structures that stabilize the soil. The team transplanted cedars from other areas of the property to along the stream bank (figure 2). The project was completed on August 21st, 2009, with a total of 16 volunteers planting approximately 50 shrubs (figure 3).
