The Laurie Lawson Outdoor Education Centre (O.E.C.) is located along portions of the Cobourg Brook. The Education Centre is highly visited and apparent trampling has been seen along the banks of the stream (figure 1). The idea of the shrub planting is to minimize erosion and increase the stability of the bank so that the O.E.C. can be continued to be used for many

more vears come. The stream bank at the site had previously been fenced off so that trail users could not step on the failing slopes and also to fence off areas where the shrubs are being planted (figure 2). On August 7th, 2009, 7 volunteers put in over 14 hours planted 33 dogwood shrubs along the Cobourg Brook at the Laurie Lawson O.E.C. (figure 3).
