



Habitat Restoration Project 2010

- Duffins Creek: Ajax, Ontario -

Greenwood Conservation Area South Riparian Planting

This planting project was located in Greenwood Conservation Area at a site where an earlier stream restoration project took place. Previously, on August 10th, a failed foot-bridge was removed and the bank was stabilized in this area with logs and displacement of river stone along the edges. The bank was in need of root structures so on October 26th, 2010, staff from the OFAH and TRCA completed the planting of trees and shrubs at this site. The team planted 315 shrubs, including willows and dogwood, and 20 trees along the banks of Duffins Creek, a distance of over 40m in length.
