This project took place on the same day as the Lower Barkey planting; November 12, 2010. The same group of 75 Fleming College students, 1 high school coop student and 10 staff went north to plant a mixture of 220 native trees and 295 shrubs (figure 1). Upper Barkey was planted to reforest old decommissioned pastureland (figure 2). The volunteer contribution for this project was 213.5 hours to plant a total area of 14,103 m² (figure 3).
